How it works

It's a simple concept...

- A presenter poses a question to the audience, either verbally or through PowerPoint*.
- Audience members consider their answer and respond using their interactive Qwizdom® handset.
- Results can be viewed privately or shown to the entire room in a barchart, piechart or participant list.
- 4. Post session, results are available instantly in Excel*, Flash* or PDF.

Audience Response System / Q2 & Q5





In addition to facilitating standards-based RF communication, the Q2 uses a three-row custom e-Ink display that supports display of three-digit numbers, right/wrong feedback and low battery.

Main Features:

- Three-row custom e-lnk display.
- Right/wrong feedback.
- Question types include Multiple Choice, Yes/No, True/False and Rating Scale.
- Smaller than Q6, lighter and improved battery conservation.
- One button answers.





The Qwizdom Q6 Audience Response System is unique as it offers more opportunities for collaboration than any other system. Each remote offers an easy-to-use keypad, text input, and a large LCD screen to view full responses.

Main Features:

- 13 different question types including: Multiple Mark, Sequencing, Rating Scale, Yes/No, Numeric (including fractions, decimals, and mixed expressions), Multiple Choice, True/False, Text Input, and Text Edit.
- View questions on-screen, text entry and text edit.
- Large LCD display with right/wrong feedback capability.
- Up to 1,000 remotes per host.

Audience Response System / Q⁵ Instructor & Q⁷ Presenter Tablet





Gain freedom and control with the Qwizdom Q5-RF Instructor Remote. Navigate between presentation slides, play and pause media, and pose new questions on-the-fly.

Enable discussion and promote participation by posing spontaneous questions and picking delegates at random. Use the backlit Q5 Instructor handset to view feedback both publicly and privately.

- Pose spontaneous questions.




Qwizdom's new wireless tablet combines advanced RF technology, presenter controls, and response system interactivity to help presenters connect and collaborate in completely new ways. Doubling as an instructor handset it allows presenters to draw, annotate, and control computer applications without being tethered to a computer. Additionally, the Q7 lets you view notes, presentation indicators and input from participants on the tablet's LCD screen.

Main Features:

- Small USB receiver that can be stored in the tablet when not in use.
- Less than 1.5 lbs makes this device compact and easy to carry around.
- LCD provides feedback on current tool selection, battery life, and network status

Actionpoint & Self-paced learning



Qwizdom Actionpoint is an easy-to-use toolbar that works within PowerPoint®. Using Actionpoint, you can customise the look and feel of your presentation: create Qwizdom presentations from scratch, import existing presentations, view response graphs, import and build participant lists, award points and set timers for each question.

Actionpoint is free to use and can be quickly installed on anyone's computer (see minimum system requirements).

Self-paced Learning

Qwizdom supports Self-Paced Learning through its Answerkey function. Answerkey lets the participant control the pace of the learning process. Users can work through presentations, evaluations, quizzes and tests at their own pace. Results can be viewed in real time and at the end of the session as a spreadsheet, barchart, piechart and personal report.

Real Time Feedback

Using Qwizdom allows presenters and instructors to view audience feedback in real time in a number of different formats including bar chart, pie chart and via participant list. Real time feedback lets presenters quickly gauge opinion, address key points, deal with misconceptions and evaluate levels of understanding.



Post Session Results

Instant Tracking

After every Qwizdom session, results are instantly available in Excel, Flash and PDF. As well as doing away with unnecessary paperwork, results can be used for further reporting, building data on individual participants and groups, analysing trends or comparing results across a number of sessions.


